STATEMENT OF CHARGES

Respondent.

On December 27, 2017, STEVEN PARR, a certified peace officer with the Lakewood Police Department (LPD), was discharged for disqualifying misconduct pursuant to former RCW 43.101.105(1)(d) (2011), former RCW 43.101.010(8)(a)(i)(B) (2008), and former RCW 43.101.010(8)(b) (2008). The disqualifying misconduct included conduct constituting a crime of dishonesty or false statement within the meaning of Evidence Rule 609(a), to wit: Making a False or Misleading Statement to a Public Servant. RCW 9A.76.175. The disqualifying misconduct is as follows:

**Count I – False Statements in IA Interview**

On multiple occasions during his internal investigation interview on November 6, 2017, PARR engaged in conduct constituting the crime of Making a False or Misleading Statement to a Public Servant when he knowingly provided false and/or misleading material statements to LPD Sergeant Scott Novasky and LPD Lieutenant Chris Westby. RCW 9A.76.175.
