STATEMENT OF CHARGES

On June 15 2020, SEAN MEENAN, a certified peace officer with the Washington State Patrol, was discharged for disqualifying misconduct pursuant to former RCW 43.101.105(1)(d) (2011) and RCW 43.101.010 (8)(a)(i)(B) and (b) (2020). The disqualifying misconduct included conduct that would constitute a crime committed under color of authority as a peace officer, to wit: Failure of Duty and/or Official Misconduct. RCW 42.20.100, RCW 9A.80.010. The disqualifying misconduct is as follows:

Count I – Failure of Duty

On or about the period between January 2017 and December 2017, MEENAN, while on-duty as a peace officer, engaged in conduct constituting the crime of Failure of Duty when he intentionally used state resources to facilitate sexual activity with a female coworker on multiple occasions. Such activity deprived the citizenry of their right to unhindered police availability, was a breach of the public’s trust, and constituted a willful neglect by MEENAN to perform his duty as a public officer. RCW 42.20.100.

AND/OR

1 **Count II – Official Misconduct**

2 On or about the period between January 2017 and December 2017, MEENAN
3 while on-duty as a peace officer, engaged in conduct constituting the crime of Official
4 Misconduct when he intentionally used state resources to facilitate sexual activity with
5 a female coworker on multiple occasions for his own personal benefit of sexual
6 gratification. MEENAN, with the intent to obtain this benefit, breached the public's trust
7 by intentionally refraining from performing a duty imposed upon him by law.
8 RCW 9A.80.010.

9 The discharge is final and some or all of the acts or omissions forming the basis
10 for the discharge proceedings occurred on or after January 1, 2002.
11 Former RCW 43.101.105(1)(d) (2011).
