STATEMENT OF CHARGES

Respondent.

On or about April 16, 2021, BRADLEY CONWAY, a certified peace officer with the Seattle Police Department (SPD), retired in lieu of termination from that agency. Prior to retiring, CONWAY engaged in conduct that failed to meet the ethical and professional standards required of a peace officer, disrupted, diminished or otherwise jeopardized public trust or confidence in the law enforcement profession, and/or demonstrated an inability or unwillingness to uphold the officer's sworn oath to enforce the Constitution and laws of the United States and the state of Washington. Such misconduct subjects CONWAY'S peace officer certification to discipline under RCW 43.101.105(3)(j)(iv) and (3)(k). The circumstances are as follows:

Count I

Between October 2019 and June 2020, CONWAY engaged in conduct that failed to meet the ethical and professional standards required of a peace officer; disrupted, diminished or otherwise jeopardized public trust or confidence in the law enforcement profession, and/or demonstrated an inability or unwillingness to uphold the officer's sworn oath to enforce the Constitution and laws of the United States and the state of

1 Washington when he purchased a controlled substance on multiple occasions without
2 a valid prescription. CONWAY'S peace officer certification is subject to discipline under
3 RCW 43.101.105(3)(j)(iv).

4 AND/OR

5 **Count II**

6 On or about August 28, 2019, during an SPD internal investigation interview,
7 CONWAY engaged in conduct that failed to meet the ethical and professional standards
8 required of a peace officer; disrupted, diminished or otherwise jeopardized public trust
9 or confidence in the law enforcement profession, and/or demonstrated an inability or
10 unwillingness to uphold the officer's sworn oath to enforce the Constitution and laws of
11 the United States and the state of Washington when he falsely denied being addicted
12 to any medication, prescription or otherwise. CONWAY'S peace officer certification is
13 subject to discipline under RCW 43.101.105(3)(j)(iv).

14 **Count III**

15 On or about April 16, 2021, CONWAY retired in lieu of discharge from his
16 employment with SPD after engaging in the misconduct alleged in Count I and Count II.
17 CONWAY'S peace officer certification is subject to discipline under
18 RCW 43.101.105(3)(k).
