STATEMENT OF CHARGES

11 Respondent.

12 On or around June 23, 2023, Officer DREW SAMUEL SEIFFERT, a certified  
13 corrections officer with Spokane County Detention Services (SCDS), was found to have  
14 committed four counts of Custodial Sexual Misconduct in the First Degree, a felony.  
15 SEIFFERT also engaged in a pattern of conduct that failed to meet the ethical and  
16 professional standards required of a peace officer and/or disrupted, diminished or  
17 otherwise jeopardized public trust or confidence in the law enforcement profession. The  
18 misconduct described above subjects SEIFFERT's peace officer certification to  
19 discipline under RCW 43.101.105(3)(j)(i) and (iv). The circumstances are as follows:

20 **COUNT I**

21 On or around June 23, 2023, SEIFFERT was found to have committed a felony  
22 when he was charged with first degree custodial sexual misconduct based on an  
23 affidavit of facts submitted by an investigator with the Spokane County Sheriff's  
24 Office (SCSO). SEIFFERT was found to have engaged in sexual intercourse with an  
25 adult female inmate while he was on duty on or around October 17, 2022. That conduct  
26 constituted custodial sexual misconduct in the first degree, a violation of

1 RCW 9A.44.160. SEIFFERT'S corrections officer certification is subject to discipline  
2 under RCW 43.101.105(3)(j)(i).

3 AND/OR

4 **COUNT II**

5 On or around June 23, 2023, SEIFFERT was found to have committed a felony  
6 when he was charged with first degree custodial sexual misconduct based on an  
7 affidavit of facts submitted by an investigator with the SCSO. SEIFFERT was found to  
8 have engaged in sexual intercourse with an adult female inmate while he was on duty  
9 on or around October 26, 2022. That conduct violated constituted custodial sexual  
10 misconduct in the first degree, a violation of RCW 9A.44.160. SEIFFERT'S corrections  
11 officer certification is subject to discipline under RCW 43.101.105(3)(j)(i).

12 AND/OR

13 **COUNT III**

14 On or around June 23, 2023, SEIFFERT was found to have committed a felony  
15 when he was charged with first degree custodial sexual misconduct based on an  
16 affidavit of facts submitted by an investigator with the SCSO. SEIFFERT was found to  
17 have engaged in sexual intercourse with an adult female inmate while he was on duty  
18 on or around November 1, 2022. That conduct constituted custodial sexual misconduct  
19 in the first degree, a violation of RCW 9A.44.160. SEIFFERT'S corrections officer  
20 certification is subject to discipline under RCW 43.101.105(3)(j)(i).

21 AND/OR

22 **COUNT IV**

23 On or around June 23, 2023, SEIFFERT was found to have committed a felony  
24 when he was charged with first degree custodial sexual misconduct based on an  
25 affidavit of facts submitted by an investigator with the SCSO. SEIFFERT was found to  
26 have engaged in sexual intercourse with an adult female inmate while he was on duty

1 on or around December 12, 2022. That conduct constituted custodial sexual misconduct  
2 in the first degree, a violation of RCW 9A.44.160. SEIFFERT'S corrections officer  
3 certification is subject to discipline under RCW 43.101.105(3)(j)(i).

4 AND/OR

5 **COUNT V**

6 Between September 17, 2022 and December 12, 2022, SEIFFERT engaged in  
7 a pattern of conduct that failed to meet the ethical and professional standards required  
8 of a peace officer and/or disrupted, diminished or otherwise jeopardized public trust or  
9 confidence in the law enforcement profession when he: (1) watched and encouraged a  
10 female inmate to masturbate in front of him on or around September 17, 2022 and again  
11 on or around September 20, 2022; and/or (2) had sexual intercourse with a female  
12 inmate while on duty on four separate occasions between October 17, 2022 and  
13 December 12, 2022; and/or (3) made false and/or misleading statements to Sergeant  
14 Gigi Parker with the SCDS Office of Professional Standards during an internal affairs  
15 interview on June 22, 2023, when he denied any sexual interactions with the female  
16 inmate discussed above. SEIFFERT'S corrections officer certification is subject to  
17 discipline under RCW 43.101.105(3)(j)(iv).
