STATEMENT OF CHARGES

On April 22, 2021, JOSEPH PEREZ-RESOP, a certified peace officer with the Sumner Police Department, was discharged for disqualifying misconduct pursuant to RCW 43.101.105(d) and RCW 43.101.010(8)(a)(i)(B). The disqualifying misconduct included conduct constituting a crime involving dishonesty or false statement within the meaning of Evidence Rule 609(a), to wit: Making a False or Misleading Statement to a Public Servant. RCW 9A.76.175. The disqualifying misconduct is as follows:


Count I

On January 29, 2021, PEREZ-RESOP, while completing the Sumner Police Department Pre-employment Psychological Screening – History Questionnaire, engaged in conduct constituting the crime of Making a False or Misleading Statement to a Public Servant when he knowingly falsified or omitted material information about a preexisting medical condition and treatment. PEREZ-RESOP knew that public servants with the Sumner Police Department were reasonably likely to rely upon these statements in the discharge of their official powers or duties. RCW 9A.76.175.

1 The discharge is final and some or all of the acts or omissions forming the basis
2 for the discharge proceedings occurred on or after January 1, 2002.
