R22-154 9 KELLY JENSON, STATEMENT OF CHARGES 10 Respondent. 11 12 On or about August 18, 2022, KELLY JENSON, a certified peace officer with the 13 Liberty Lake Police Department (LLPD), engaged in conduct that failed to meet the 14 ethical and professional standards required of a peace officer; disrupted, diminished or 15 otherwise jeopardized public trust or confidence in the law enforcement profession; or 16 demonstrated an inability or unwillingness to uphold the officer's sworn oath to enforce 17 the Constitution and laws of the United States and the state of Washington. Such 18 misconduct subjects JENSON'S peace officer certification to discipline under 19 RCW 43.101.105(3)(j)(iv). The circumstances are as follows: 20 Count I 21 On or about August 18, 2022, JENSON, while on duty as a peace officer with the 22 LLPD, failed to meet the ethical and professional standards required of a peace officer 23 and/or disrupted, diminished or otherwise jeopardized public trust or confidence in the 24 law enforcement profession and/or demonstrated an inability or unwillingness to uphold 25 the officer's sworn oath to enforce the Constitution and laws of the United States and 26 the state of Washington. Specifically, despite being aware that the incident to which he

1	responded involved potential allegations of domestic violence assault and domestic
2	violence residential burglary, JENSON: (1) failed to properly investigate, document,
3	and/or ensure the investigation was completed in accord with applicable laws and LLPD
4	policies; and/or (2) neglected his duty by failing to enforce laws violated during the
5	incident; and/or (3) failed to intervene when he was aware, or reasonably should have
6	been aware, of witness tampering by another LLPD officer during this investigation;
7	and/or (4) deactivated his bodyworn camera while directly participating in responding to
8	the incident. JENSON'S peace officer certification is subject to discipline under
9	RCW 43.101.105(3)(j)(iv).
