R22-172 10 **WOODY HEATH** STATEMENT OF CHARGES 11 Respondent. 12 On or about September 5, 2022, WOODY HEATH, a certified peace officer with the King County Sheriff's Office (KCSO), engaged in unsafe practices involving 13 14 firearms, weapons, or vehicles which indicate either a willful or wanton disregard for the 15 safety of persons or property. Additionally, HEATH engaged in conduct that failed to meet the ethical and professional standards required of a peace officer; disrupted, 16 diminished or otherwise jeopardized public trust or confidence in the law enforcement 17 18 profession; or demonstrated an inability or unwillingness to uphold the officer's sworn 19 oath to enforce the Constitution and laws of the United States and the state of Washington. Such misconduct subjects HEATH's peace officer certification to discipline 20 21 under RCW 43.101.105(3)(j)(iii) and (3)(j)(iv). The circumstances are as follows: 22 Count I On or about September 5, 2022, HEATH engaged in unsafe practices involving 23 24 firearms, weapons, or vehicles when he: (1) drove his personal vehicle in excess of 100 25 miles per hour in a 60 miles per hour zone; and/or (2) drove his vehicle in the manner described above after having consumed at least thirteen bottles of beer and two mini 26

1	bottles of liquor; and/or (3) used his vehicle to attempt to evade a Washington State
2	Patrol (WSP) trooper; and/or (4) abandoned his vehicle while it was still running in a
3	further attempt to evade the WSP trooper; and/or (5) left a loaded handgun on the
4	driver's seat of his abandoned running vehicle. These unsafe practices indicate either
5	a willful or wanton disregard for the safety of persons or property. Following this
6	misconduct, HEATH pleaded guilty to Negligent Driving in the First Degree -
7	RCW 46.61.5249. HEATH'S peace officer certification is subject to discipline under
8	RCW 43.101.105(3)(j)(iii)
9	AND/OR
10	Count II
11	On or about September 5, 2022, HEATH engaged in conduct that failed to meet
12	the ethical and professional standards required of a peace officer; disrupted, diminished
13	or otherwise jeopardized public trust or confidence in the law enforcement profession;
14	or demonstrated an inability or unwillingness to uphold the officer's sworn oath to
15	enforce the Constitution and laws of the United States and the state of Washington
16	when he: (1) engaged in any of the misconduct described in Count I; and/or (2)
17	attempted to use his position as a peace officer to influence a WSP trooper to not arrest
18	him; and/or (3) was discourteous to officers involved in his arrest. HEATH'S peace
19	officer certification is subject to discipline under RCW 43.101.105(3)(j)(iv).
