STATEMENT OF CHARGES

On or about November 14, 2019, Travis M. Morley, a certified peace officer with the Douglas County Sheriff's Office, was discharged for disqualifying misconduct pursuant to RCW 43.101.010 (8)(a)(i)(B) and (b). The disqualifying misconduct included conduct constituting a crime involving dishonesty or false statement within the meaning of Evidence Rule 609(a) to wit: Making a False or Misleading Statement to a Public Servant. RCW 9A.76.175. The disqualifying misconduct is as follows:

Count I

On or about September 5, 2019, MORLEY engaged in behavior constituting the crime of Making a False or Misleading Statement to a Public Servant when he knowingly provided material false and/or misleading statements to Detective Sergeant Jason DeMyer during an internal investigation interview. MORLEY knew that public servants with the Douglas County Sheriff's Office were reasonably likely to rely upon his statements in the discharge of their official powers or duties.

AND/OR


1 **Count II**

2 On or about October 17, 2019, MORLEY engaged in behavior constituting the
3 crime of Making a False or Misleading Statement to a Public Servant when he
4 knowingly provided material false and/or misleading statements to Detective Sergeant
5 Jason DeMyer during an internal investigation interview. MORLEY knew that public
6 servants with the Douglas County Sheriff's Office were reasonably likely to rely upon
7 his statements in the discharge of their official powers or duties.

8 The discharge is final and some or all of the acts or omissions forming the
9 basis for the discharge proceedings occurred on or after January 1, 2002.
10 RCW 43.101.105 (1) (c) and (d).
