STATEMENT OF CHARGES

On April 24, 2015, LEE GASKILL, a certified peace officer with the Algona Police Service, was discharged for disqualifying misconduct as defined by RCW 43.101.105(d), RCW 43.101.010(8)(a)(i)(B), and RCW 43.101.010(8)(b). The disqualifying misconduct included conduct constituting a crime a committed under color of authority as a peace officer, to wit: Official Misconduct. RCW 9A.80.010. The disqualifying misconduct is as follows:

Count I

Between February 21, 2012 and November 4, 2014, GASKILL engaged in conduct constituting the crime of Official Misconduct when, with the intent to personally benefit, he intentionally used his position as a peace officer to access and spend funds belonging to the South Valley Explorers. RCW 9A.80.010.
