STATEMENT OF CHARGES

On September 14, 2017, PHILIP C. WALL, a certified peace officer with the Seattle Police Department, was discharged for disqualifying misconduct as defined by former RCW 43.101.105(d) and former RCW 43.101.010(8)(a)(i)(B). The disqualifying misconduct included conduct constituting a crime involving the unlawful use or possession of a controlled substance, to wit: Cocaine. RCW 69.50.101(g); RCW 69.50.206(b)(4); RCW 69.50.4013(1). The disqualifying misconduct is as follows:

Count I


On numerous occasions between June 2014 and March 2016, WALL engaged in conduct constituting a crime involving the unlawful use and/or possession of Cocaine, a Schedule II controlled substance within the meaning of RCW 69.50.101(g). RCW 69.50.206(b)(4); RCW 69.50.4013(1).
