Head, eye, and throat protection will be provided by ALERRT

the first responder to isolate, distract, and neutralize an active shooter. This course will cover:

- shooting and moving
- threshold evaluation
- concepts and principles of team movement
- setting up for and room entry techniques
- approach and breaching the crisis site
- secondary responder tactics
- improvised explosive devices
- post engagement priorities of work.

The course will culminate with dynamic force-on-force scenarios.
