Course Description

This Track I course will deepen a student's understanding of leadership, followership, and self to improve their work and personal relationships with others. Information and skills developed in this course will assist students in gaining a broader perspective of the law enforcement profession, the personalities that exist in it, teams, culture, history, followership responsibilities, and leadership from wherever they're at within the police organization. Blue Line Leadership is a great course for those influential peer leaders on your team; those who are thriving and those who have become disenfranchised, frustrated, or disappointed; those emerging leaders who desire to promote or achieve specialty assignments; and those who desire a deeper and broader understanding of our chosen profession.

This course is specifically designed for and restricted to deputies, police officers, FTO's, corporals, detectives, limited commission, and non-commissioned personnel of all tenure and assignment.
