The Washington State Patrol will be hosting Vehicle Identification (VIN) Basics Training June 1 -1 , 2024. The class includes the basics and more in-depth training of VIN identification essential for anyone likely to encounter missing or altered VINs, stolen, cloned and VIN switched vehicles.

NOTE: VIN Officers may, but are not required to attend this year due to a specialized VIN course provided for them.

The training provides techniques to identify a vehicle using all of the unique identifiers applied during manufacturing. The class is a total of 32 hours, and discusses abandoned vehicles, obliterated identifiers, chemical number restoration, and basic and advanced identification techniques. It also includes hands-on instruction in vehicle identification. Wednesday and Friday will be off site practical training, location information will be provided.

Who Should Attend:

Detectives, VIN Officers, law enforcement and code enforcement officers, health and ecology investigators who investigate or inspect vehicles as part of their enforcement duties, any WSP, DOL or NICB support personnel who assist with VIN issues.
