IMPORTANT NOTICE

King County Stakeholders,

The CIT-King County Program is working to implement training for Fall 2021.

Due to the COVID-19 pandemic and the Delta Variant transmission increases within King County and other extenuating legislative circumstances, the CIT-King CO 40-HR Basic classes will be postponed until January 2022. *The schedule will be posted in ACADIS for registration by September 15, 2021. The schedule will run through June 30, 2023.*

Additional CIT In-Services for law enforcement will be scheduled virtually for Fall 2021. The program will complete curricula updates for the CIT-Youth 8-HR class so it can launch virtually in Winter 2021.

Other Training

The CIT-King CO Program will host training classes supported by the CIT Trueblood program to meet the **Trueblood v. DSHS Lawsuit**.

Pursuant to the settlement agreement the following applies:

1. **All** city and county law enforcement agencies within Phase 2 (King County Region) will have at a **minimum 25%** of their active commissioned personnel through a CIT 40-HR Basic class by June 30, 2023. (18 offerings)
2. **All** city and county law enforcement/corrections agencies within Phase 2 (King County Region) must have **ALL** corrections officers through the CIT 8-HR Corrections In-Service class by June 30, 2023. (60 offerings)
3. **All** dispatch/911 entities within Phase 2 (King County Region) that provide PSAP support to public safety must have **ALL** dispatchers, call-takers, and telecommunicators through the CIT 8-HR 911/Dispatch In-Service by June 30, 2023. (Link on website.)

Updated: A presentation regarding the Trueblood Lawsuit will be provided on Friday, October 29, 2021, 9 AM – 10:30 AM at the CIT-King CO Coordinator Committee Meeting via ZOOM. If you wish to attend, please RSVP to cit@cjtc.wa.gov. I will be sending each agency follow-up information on agency status complying with the settlement requirements, as applicable.
