Mission Planning

FREE Training: 02-03 NOV 2021 from 0800-1700

Where: Building 104, Camp Murray, WA

This course applies military mission planning techniques to law enforcement operations. The course introduces general frameworks to help students plan missions and lead their tactical teams. The course goals are to improve time and information management as well as risk mitigation in mission planning to support the foundational goal of officer safety. This course is designed to be highly experiential and hands-on. Lead instructor is Special Forces soldier with 6 combat deployments.

Day 1: Plan a Time-Constrained Mission

- Students work in teams to use Tactical Leading Procedures (TLPs) to develop a plan for a real-world time-constrained mission
- The plan will be put into a 1-slide Concept-of-the-Operation (CONOP) format
- Students will receive a quick class on briefing and then brief their plan to the instructors and rest of class

Day 2: Plan a High-Risk Mission

- Students will use Tactical Decision Making Process (TDMP) to deliberately plan for a real-world high-risk mission
- Plan will be written in the more elaborate Operation Orders format
- Students will brief plan to instructors and class
- Students will receive a class on how to lead an After Action Review (AAR) and will then participate in an AAR at the end of the class
