Commercial Vehicle Safety Alliance (CVSA) Training

CVSA Certification courses are available at the Washington State Patrol Academy for Part A, Part B and Size Weight and Load

Time: 5 days (40 Hours) for Part A (Oct. 9-13, 2023) 5 days (40 Hours) for Part B (Oct. 16-20, 2023)

4 Days (28 hours) for Size, Weight and Load (Oct. 23-26, 2023)

This course includes:

- Performance-based scenario exercises incorporating authentic assessment that employ practice with feedback
- Knowledge Checks
- End-of-course examination

Recommended Equipment: Bump cap, safety glasses, gloves, soapstone with holder, six inch ruler, razor blade type scraper, a small putty knife, a tread depth gauge, a feeler gauge, a min.30' tape measure, a commercial vehicle tire pressure gauge (capable of reading pressure's up to 140 psi) and an air brake chamber tool.

These courses are open to Federal, state, and local law enforcement personnel responsible for applying the appropriate regulation and standards for inspection of Commercial Motor Vehicles (CMVs). Most students may have fewer than five years of professional experience though others may have 20 or more year of experience in similar positions.

There is no cost for this training. All books, study guides and reference material will be provided on the first day of class.
