**Cellular Records and Electronic Service
Provider Data for Your Investigation**

WHAT:

This training is for state, local, tribal, and federal law enforcement, investigators, TFO's, analysts, and attorneys and is focused on familiarizing you with the resources, and capabilities available to you through the FBI Cellular Analysis Survey Team (CAST) and will cover the aspects below. Of note, this training is not on the extraction / exploitation of physical devices.



- Basic principles and concepts of a cellular network and how a cellular device connects with a cell tower; Overview of call detail records obtained from the major cellular providers (AT&T, GCI, Sprint, T-Mobile, and Verizon); Mapping software options; Understand the capabilities and limitations of cellular record analysis; Social media capabilities (Facebook, Instagram, Snapchat, etc.); Other electronic service providers (Apple, Google, Samsung, Comcast); Use and Limitations of obtaining cellular "tower dump" records; Be familiar with the resources available through CAST.

In addition, AUSA Pat Cashman will provide guidance on DOJ policies regarding obtaining cell site information, non-disclosure requirements, and how to effectively build this evidence into your investigation using best practices to ensure we are bringing the strongest evidence to trial. AUSA Cashman will go over key aspects to consider when you are preparing legal process/search warrants seeking the cellular data CAST utilizes.

Fairchild AFB Access / Directions to Education Center

Access Fairchild AFB off Hwy 2 in Airway Heights at the Main Gate where the Visitor Center is Located **

- Take Mitchell St South to Castle St.
- Turn West onto Castle St. and follow it to Strategic Air Command Blvd.
- Turn Northwest onto Strategic Air Command Blvd.
- Enter the Education Center / Fairchild AFB Library Parking lot at 6 Castle St.

** Sworn law enforcement can enter with their badge, and valid credentials.

** Non-sworn personnel MUST submit their Name, Date of Birth, and full Social Security Number to the course registration contact a minimum of 14 calendar days prior to the course to ensure they are added to the base entry access list.

On the day of class non-sworn personnel are required to have a REAL-ID compliant identification card, or 2 forms of ID such as a birth certificate, state license, social security card, or passport.
