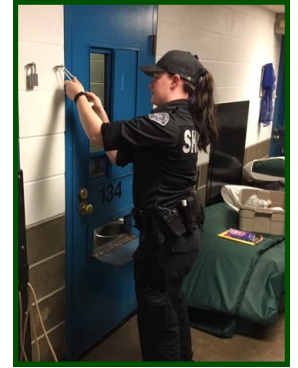
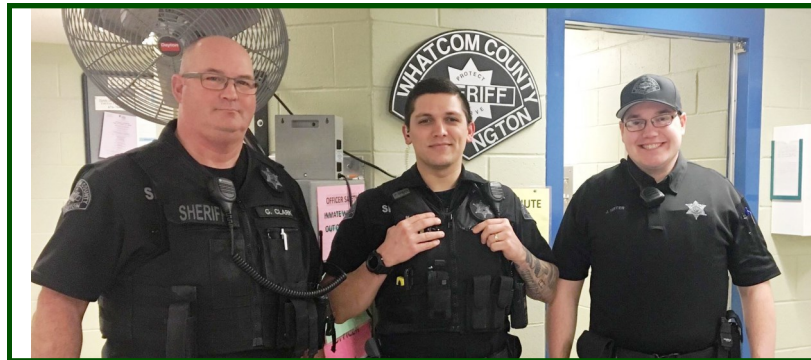
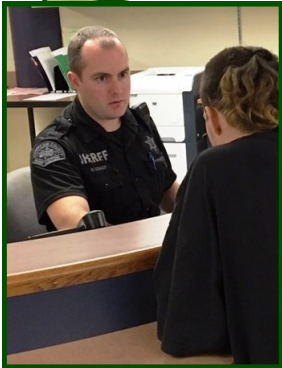

The Whatcom County Sheriff's Office has a staff of 190 employees under the leadership of Sheriff, Bill Elfo. The Corrections Division consists of the Main Jail, which holds approximately 245 full-custody offenders; a minimum-security Jail Work Center, which holds 155 offenders; and a Jail Alternatives Center, which supervises programs (Electronic Home Detention/Monitoring, Work Release, In- and Out-of-Custody Work Crews) to allow offenders to satisfy court jail time requirements without being held in the main jail.
