

WASHINGTON STATE CRIMINAL JUSTICE TRAINING COMMISSION Independent Investigation Team Qualified Lead Investigator Requirements for Obtaining IIT Lead Investigator Certificate

Purpose: The Independent Investigation Team (III) Qualified Lead Investigator Certificate was created after <u>WAC 139-12</u> went into effect on January 5, 2020. The goal is to ensure those assigned to a lead investigator role for an IIT meet all training and experience requirements. Process: Provide proof of at least three years of uninterrupted experience as a certified peace officer, crime scene investigator, or related expertise in a discipline relevant to investigations. The applicant must also be employed at a member agency of an IIT. Provide proof of successful completion of: Basic Homicide Investigation Interviewing and Interrogation (Preferably a trauma-informed interview class) ElETCSA 24-hour Patrol Tactics In-Service Course Proof: Provide proof of at least three years of uninterrupted experience as a certified peace officer, crime scene Investigator, or related expertise in a discipline relevant to investigations.
