Subject of possible rule making: Law Enforcement Training and Community Safety Act—Independent Investigations Criteria (LETCSA) WAC 139-12

Statutes authorizing the agency to adopt rules on this subject: RCW 10.114.011

Reasons why rules on this subject may be needed and what they might accomplish: Due to new legislation and AGO report, the WSCJTC is seeking to update and clarify language for Independent Investigational Teams (IITs) to conduct independent investigations of police use of deadly force.

Identify other federal and state agencies that regulate this subject and the process coordinating the rule with these agencies: RCW 10.114.011 specifically excludes federal consent decree, federal settlement agreement, or federal court order that holds authority over a law enforcement agency. No other state agency regulates this process. Coordination with Federal or other state agencies is not required.
