The Washington State Criminal Justice Training Commission is looking to add an active full-time Law Enforcement or Corrections Officer to our Firearms Cadre. Position Summary:

Contractors provide full-time services to the WSCJTC by instructing and coordinating firearms training for the Basic Law Enforcement Academy. The selected contractor will serve under the direction of the Applied Skills Training Division's Firearms Program Manager.

This position will start with a one-year Memorandum of Understanding, for which the WSCJTC will reimburse the Employing Agency up to \$85 ,000.00 of the Officer's salary and benefits.

Requirements:

Qualified candidates for this position will be evaluated on the following criteria:

- Background as a Firearms Instructor
- Successful completion of WSCJTC Firearms Level One Handgun Instructor course
- Teaching certifications
- Formal Emotional Intelligence training (i.e. Blue Courage, Patrol Tactics Instructor, ABLE)
- Experience as mentor/trainer
- Endorsement letter from Agency Chief/Sheriff
