STATEMENT OF CHARGES

On or about February 25, 2023, VICTOR OLVERA, JR., a certified peace officer with Kitsap County Sheriff's Office (KCSO), engaged in conduct that failed to meet the ethical and professional standards required of a peace officer; disrupted, diminished or otherwise jeopardized public trust or confidence in the law enforcement profession; and/or demonstrated an inability or unwillingness to uphold his sworn oath to enforce the Constitution and laws of the United States and the state of Washington. After engaging in this misconduct, OLVERA was terminated from employment with the KCSO on or about June 14, 2023. Such misconduct subjects OLVERA'S peace officer certification to discipline under RCW 43.101.105(3)(j)(iv) and (3)(k). The circumstances are as follows:

**COUNT I**

1 On or about February 25, 2023, OLVERA engaged in conduct that failed to meet  
2 the ethical and professional standards required of a peace officer; disrupted, diminished  
3 or otherwise jeopardized public trust or confidence in the law enforcement profession;  
4 and/or demonstrated an inability or unwillingness to uphold his sworn oath to enforce  
5 the Constitution and laws of the United States and the state of Washington when he:  
6 (1) engaged in conduct constituting the crime of Assault in the Fourth Degree –  
7 Domestic Violence, contrary to RCW 43.101.105(3)(j)(iv); and/or (2) made false or  
8 misleading statements to one or more officers with the Bremerton Police Department;  
9 and/or (3) interfered with the statement of a potential witness. OLVERA’S peace officer  
10 certification is subject to discipline under RCW 43.101.105(3)(j)(iv).

**COUNT II**

14 On or about June 14, 2023, OLVERA was discharged or otherwise separated  
15 from employment with the KCSO after engaging in the misconduct described in Count I.  
16 OLVERA’s peace officer certification is subject to discipline under  
17 RCW 43.101.105(3)(k).
