STATEMENT OF CHARGES

On or about December 20, 2022, ROSA OJEDA-LOPEZ, a certified police officer with the Seattle Police Department (SPD), was terminated from her employment after engaging in conduct that failed to meet the ethical and professional standards required of a peace officer and/or disrupted, diminished, or otherwise jeopardized public trust or confidence in the law enforcement profession. Such misconduct subjects OJEDA-LOPEZ's peace officer certification to discipline under RCW 43.101.105(3)(j)(iv) and (3)(k). The circumstances are as follows:

Count I

On or about August 17, 2020, OJEDA-LOPEZ engaged in conduct that failed to meet the ethical and professional standards required of a peace officer and/or disrupted, diminished, or otherwise jeopardized the public's trust and confidence in the law enforcement profession. Specifically, on the above mentioned date, OJEDA-LOPEZ became highly intoxicated while off-duty at a former SPD colleague's going away party, and on two occasions in the same evening, assaulted her domestic partner by charging

1 at her and hitting her several times in the upper torso and face area. OJEDA-LOPEZ's
2 peace officer certification is therefore subject to discipline under
3 RCW 43.101.105(3)(j)(iv).

6 **Count II**

7 On or about December 20, 2022, OJEDA-LOPEZ was terminated from SPD for
8 the conduct described in Count I. This subjects her certification to discipline under
9 RCW 43.101.105(3)(k).
