STATEMENT OF CHARGES

On or about March 4, 2023, GEORGE HERRMANN, a certified corrections officer with Spokane County Detention Services (SCDS), engaged in conduct that failed to meet the ethical and professional standards required of a corrections officer and disrupted, diminished, and damaged the public’s trust and confidence in the correctional system in violation of RCW 43.101.105(3)(j)(iv). Such misconduct subjects HERRMANN’S corrections officer certification to discipline. The misconduct is as follows:

**COUNT I**

On or about March 4, 2023, while on duty as an SCDS corrections officer, HERRMANN engaged in conduct that failed to meet the ethical and professional standards required of a corrections officer and/or disrupted, diminished, or damaged the public’s trust and confidence in the correctional system when he struck an inmate in the head while transporting the inmate in a wheelchair from one area of the Spokane County Jail to another area. HERRMANN’S misconduct resulted in criminal charges being filed against him by the Spokane County Prosecutor’s Office on May 24, 2023 in

1 Spokane County District Court (Case No. PX0230108) under RCW 9A.36.041 (Assault  
2 4th Degree). HERRMANN'S peace officer certification is therefore subject to discipline  
3 under RCW 43.101.105(3)(j)(iv).
