STATEMENT OF CHARGES

On or about April 25, 2022, LEVENTINE HALL, a certified peace officer formerly employed with the Sauk-Suiattle Tribal Police Department, was convicted of a felony offense under the laws of the State of Washington, subjecting his peace officer certification to mandatory revocation under RCW 43.101.105(2)(a)(i)(A). The felony conviction is as follows:

COUNT I

On or about April 25, 2022, HALL pleaded guilty to the crime of Harassment – Threats to Kill in Skagit County Superior Court No. 21-1-00160-29. RCW 9A.46.020(2)(b). Because Harassment – Threats to Kill is a Class C felony, this conviction subjects HALL’s peace officer certification to mandatory revocation. RCW 43.101.105(2)(a)(i)(A).
