Additionally, NEGRETE 16 engaged in conduct that failed to meet the ethical and professional standards required 17 of a peace officer, disrupted, diminished or otherwise jeopardized public trust or 18 confidence in the law enforcement profession, and/or demonstrated an inability or 19 unwillingness to uphold his sworn oath to enforce the Constitution and laws of the United 20 States and the state of Washington. Such misconduct subjects NEGRETE'S police 21 officer certification to discipline under RCW 43.101.105(3)(j)(iii), (3)(j)(iv), and (3)(k). 22 The circumstances are as follows: 23 Count I 24 On or about March 10, 2021, NEGRETE engaged in unsafe practices involving 25 firearms, weapons, or vehicles which indicate either a willful or wanton disregard for the 26 safety of persons or property when, while under the influence of intoxicating liquor, he

drove his personal vehicle off the roadway and damaged the property of another. On or
about March 12, 2021, NEGRETE was criminally charged in Yakima Municipal Court
Case No. 1A0275942 with violating RCW 46.61.502 and RCW 46.61.5055 – Driving
While Under the Influence. NEGRETE'S peace officer certification is subject to
discipline under RCW 43.101.105(3)(j)(iii).
AND/OR
Count II
On or about March 10, 2021, NEGRETE engaged in conduct that failed to meet
the ethical and professional standards required of a peace officer; disrupted, diminished
or otherwise jeopardized public trust or confidence in the law enforcement profession,
and/or demonstrated an inability or unwillingness to uphold his sworn oath to enforce
the Constitution and laws of the United States and the state of Washington when he:
(1) engaged in the conduct described in Count I; and/or (2) made false and/or
misleading statements to law enforcement officers who responded to the scene of his
DUI collision. NEGRETE'S peace officer certification is subject to discipline under
RCW 43.101.105(3)(j)(iv).
AND/OR
Count III
On or about May 3, 2021, NEGRETE was discharged from his employment with
SPD after engaging in the misconduct alleged in Count I and Count II. NEGRETE'S
peace officer certification is subject to discipline under RCW 43.101.105(3)(k).
