12	On or about May 3, 2022, DANIEL WALWARK, a certified peace officer with	
13	Thurston County Sheriff's Office (TCSO), was terminated from his employment after	
14	engaging in conduct that failed to meet the ethical and professional standards required	
15	of a peace officer, and/or disrupted, diminished, or otherwise jeopardized public trust of	
16	confidence in the law enforcement profession. Such misconduct subjects WALWARK's	
17	police officer certification to discipline under RCW 43.101.105(3)(j)(iv) and (k). The	
18	circumstances are as follows:	
19	<u>Count I</u>	
20	On or about January 27, 2022, W	ALWARK engaged in conduct that failed to
21	meet the ethical and professional standards required of a peace officer and/or disrupted	
22	diminished, or otherwise jeopardized public trust or confidence in the law enforcemen	
23	profession when, while off duty, he was involved in a domestic violence incident	
24	involving his intimate partner. WALWARK was found to have violated TSCO Policy	
25	No. 230.5.9(m), which prohibits conduct	unbecoming a member of the TCSO.

1	WALWARK's peace officer certification is therefore subject to discipline under	
2	RCW 43.101.105(3)(j)(iv).	
3	AND/OR	
4	Count II	
5	Between approximately January 1, 2021 and May 3, 2022, WALWARK engaged	
6	in conduct that failed to meet the ethical and professional standards required of a peace	
7	officer and/or disrupted, diminished, or otherwise jeopardized public trust or confidence	
8	in the law enforcement profession when he participated in producing and posting	
9	sexually explicit material to on-line social media platforms, including images of his	
10	naked body. WALWARK was was later found to have violated TSCO policies as a result	
11	of this conduct, including TSCO Policy No. 230.5.9, which prohibits conduct	
12	unbecoming a member of the TCSO and TCSO Policy No. 1030.4(b)(3), which governs	
13	sexually explicit speech and/or expression of TCSO members. WALWARK'S peace	
14	officer certification is therefore subject to discipline under RCW 43.101.105(3)(j)(iv).	
15	AND/OR	
16	Count III	
17	WALWARK was discharged from his employment with TCSO after the	
18	misconduct alleged in Counts I and II occured. WALWARK's peace officer certification	
19	is therefore subject to discipline under RCW 43.101.105(3)(k).
