STATEMENT OF CHARGES

12 On or about July 6, 2020, ROBERT GOSS, a certified peace officer with the 13 Tieton Police Department (TPD), resigned in lieu of termination from that agency. Prior 14 to his resignation, GOSS knowingly made multiple misleading, deceptive, untrue, or 15 fraudulent representations in the practice of being a peace officer. Additionally, GOSS 16 engaged in conduct that failed to meet the ethical and professional standards required 17 of a peace officer; disrupted, diminished or otherwise jeopardized public trust or 18 confidence in the law enforcement profession, and/or demonstrated an inability or 19 unwillingness to uphold his sworn oath to enforce the Constitution and laws of the United 20 States and the state of Washington. GOSS's peace officer certification is subject to 21 discipline under RCW 43.101.105(2)(d), (3)(j)(iv) and (3)(k). The circumstances are as 22 follows:

COUNT I

On or about June 29, 2020, GOSS knowingly made misleading, deceptive,
untrue, or fraudulent representations in the practice of being a peace officer.
Specifically, GOSS made false and/or misleading statements to TPD Chief

Jeff Ketchum regarding his actions in bringing his son and girlfriend to the Reserve
Academy without authorization. After making these false and/or misleading statements,
GOSS resigned in lieu of termination on or about July 6, 2020. GOSS's peace officer
certification is subject to mandatory revocation under RCW 43.101.105(2)(d).

COUNT II

On or about June 29, 2020, GOSS knowingly made misleading, deceptive, 7 untrue, or fraudulent representations in the practice of being a peace officer. 8 Specifically, GOSS knowingly made false and/or misleading statements to TPD Chief 9 Jeff Ketchum about his compliance with a direct order given by TPD Chief Jeff Ketchum 10 regarding having his patrol vehicle at his girlfriend's residence. After making these false 11 and/or misleading statements, GOSS resigned in lieu of termination on or about July 6, 12 2020. GOSS's peace officer certification is subject to mandatory revocation under RCW 13 43.101.105(2)(d). 14

AND/OR

COUNT III

Between approximately June 1 and July 6, 2020, GOSS engaged in conduct that 17 failed to meet the ethical and professional standards required of a peace officer; 18 disrupted, diminished or otherwise jeopardized public trust or confidence in the law 19 enforcement profession, and/or demonstrated an inability or unwillingness to uphold the 20 officer's sworn oath to enforce the Constitution and laws of the United States and the 21 state of Washington when he: (1) made false and/or misleading statements to TPD 22 Chief Jeff Ketchum as described in Count I and Count II; (2) brought his girlfriend and 23 son to the Reserve Academy without authorization, allowed his girlfriend and son to 24 attend a firearm training without authorization, and drove his son on the high speed 25 Emergency Vehicle Operations Course (EVOC) without permission; and (3) parked his 26

1	patrol vehicle across from his girlfriend's home around 50 times in the month of June in
2	violation of a direct order from Chief Ketchum. GOSS's peace officer certification is
3	subject to discipline under RCW 43.101.105(3)(j)(iv).
4	AND/OR
5	<u>COUNT IV</u>
6	On or about July 6, 2020, GOSS separated from his employment with TPD after
7	engaging in the misconduct described in Counts I, II, and III. GOSS's peace officer
8	certification is subject to discipline under RCW 43.101.105(3)(k).
