NO. 21-042 STATEMENT OF CHARGES

ALEXANDER EVERETT

Respondent.

On or about August 6, 2021, ALEXANDER EVERETT, a certified peace officer with the Seattle Police Department (SPD), was terminated by his employer after he knowingly made misleading, deceptive, untrue, or fraudulent representations in the practice of being a peace officer. Such misconduct subjects EVERETT's peace officer certification to discipline under RCW 43.101.105(2)(d), (3)(j)(iv), and (3)(k). The circumstances are as follows:

<u>COUNT I</u>

On or between January 6 and June 4, 2021, EVERETT made misleading, deceptive, untrue, or fraudulent representations in the practice of being a peace officer when, during an internal investigation into his activities on January 6, 2021, he: (1) falsely reported he was unaware that a political protest he was participating in at the United States Capitol had developed into an illegal riot; and/or (2) falsely claimed to be unaware he was illegally trespassing on Capitol grounds. As a result of this misconduct,

<u>COUNT II</u>

On or between January 6 and June 4, 2021, EVERETT engaged in conduct that
failed to meet the ethical and professional standards of a peace officer when, while in
Washington D.C. on January 6, 2021 and in subsequent discussions of this event,
EVERETT: (1) engaged in conduct constituting a violation of D.C. Code
22-3301(Unlawful Entry) by trespassing on U.S. Capitol grounds; and/or (2) attempted
to downplay his involvement in, and knowledge of, the riot that occurred at the U.S.
Capitol on January 6, 2021. EVERETT's conduct violated RCW 43.101.105(3)(j)(iv).

AND/OR

COUNT III

On or about August 6, 2021, EVERETT was discharged by SPD after engaging
in the misconduct described in Count II. EVERETT's peace officer certification is subject
to discipline under RCW 43.101.105(3)(k).
