STATEMENT OF CHARGES

Respondent.

On or about October 9, 2023, MICHAEL PHIPPS, a certified peace officer formerly employed with the Pierce County Sheriff's Office, was convicted of two felony offenses under the laws of the State of Washington, subjecting his peace officer certification to mandatory revocation under RCW 43.101.105(2)(a)(i)(A). The felony convictions are as follows:

COUNT I

On or about October 9, 2023, PHIPPS pleaded guilty to the crime of Malicious Mischief in the First Degree in Pierce County Superior Court No. 22-1-01391-7. RCW 9A.48.070. Because Malicious Mischief in the First Degree is a Class B felony, this conviction subjects PHIPPS's peace officer certification to mandatory revocation. RCW 43.101.105(2)(a)(i)(A).

AND/OR:

COUNT II

On or about October 9, 2023, PHIPPS pleaded guilty to the crime of Stalking in Pierce County Superior Court No. 22-1-01391-7. RCW 9A.46.110(5)(b). Because

1 Stalking under subsection (5)(b) is a Class B felony, this conviction subjects PHIPPS's
2 peace officer certification to mandatory revocation. RCW 43.101.105(2)(a)(i)(A).
