AL SALEHI (AL SALEHI), a certified 13 peace officer with the Seattle Police Department (SPD), was terminated from that 14 agency after engaging in conduct that failed to meet the ethical and professional 15 standards required of a peace officer and/or disrupted, diminished, or otherwise 16 jeopardized public trust or confidence in the law enforcement profession. Additionally, 17 shortly after his termination, AL SALEHI was prohibited from possessing a weapon by 18 state law and/or a permanent court order following a hearing. AL SALEHI's peace 19 officer certification is subject to discipline under RCW 43.101.105(3)(j)(iv) and (3)(k) 20 and mandatory revocation under RCW 43.101.105(2)(e). The circumstances are as 21 follows: 22 **COUNT I** 23 On or about November 1, 2023, following a hearing in criminal case #668269, 24 the Municipal Court of the City of Seattle issued a Stalking No-Contact Order against 25

AL SALEHI. The Order prohibits AL SALEHI from accessing, obtaining, or possessing

firearms or other dangerous weapons. The Court based its decision on RCW 9.41.800(4), which prohibits any party who presents a serious and imminent threat to public health or safety, or to the health or safety of any individual, from possessing a firearm. AL SALEHI's peace officer certification is subject to mandatory revocation under RCW 43.101.105(2)(e).

COUNT II

Between approximately December 2021 to November 2023, AL SALEHI engaged in conduct that failed to meet the ethical and professional standards required of a peace officer and/or disrupted, diminished, or otherwise jeopardized public trust or confidence in the law enforcement profession when he: (1) repeatedly contacted and harassed a female citizen online and via text message; and/or (2) made false and/or misleading statements during a criminal investigation related to the harassment described in (1); and/or (3) based on the harassment described in (1), was criminally charged with Domestic Violence Cyberstalking (former SMC 12A.06.045)¹ in Seattle Municipal Court Case #668269; and/or (4) was prohibited pursuant to a Stalking No-Contact Order from being within 1,000 feet of the female citizen for a period of five years; and/or (5) was prohibited pursuant to a Stalking No-Contact Order from owning, obtaining, or accessing any firearms or dangerous weapons for a period of five years. AL SALEHI's peace officer certification is subject to discipline under RCW 43.101.105(3)(j)(iv).

2	On or about October 25, 2022, AL SALEHI was terminated from SPD after
3	engaging in the misconduct described in Count II. AL SALEHI's peace officer
4	certification is subject to discipline under RCW 43.101.105(3)(k).
