STATEMENT OF CHARGES

On or about October 25, 2022, JAFAR L. AL SALEHI (AL SALEHI), a certified peace officer with the Seattle Police Department (SPD), was terminated from that agency after engaging in conduct that failed to meet the ethical and professional standards required of a peace officer and/or disrupted, diminished, or otherwise jeopardized public trust or confidence in the law enforcement profession. Additionally, shortly after his termination, AL SALEHI was prohibited from possessing a weapon by state law and/or a permanent court order following a hearing. AL SALEHI’s peace officer certification is subject to discipline under RCW 43.101.105(3)(j)(iv) and (3)(k) and mandatory revocation under RCW 43.101.105(2)(e). The circumstances are as follows:

COUNT I

On or about November 1, 2023, following a hearing in criminal case #668269, the Municipal Court of the City of Seattle issued a Stalking No-Contact Order against AL SALEHI. The Order prohibits AL SALEHI from accessing, obtaining, or possessing

1 firearms or other dangerous weapons. The Court based its decision on
2 RCW 9.41.800(4), which prohibits any party who presents a serious and imminent
3 threat to public health or safety, or to the health or safety of any individual, from
4 possessing a firearm. AL SALEHI's peace officer certification is subject to mandatory
5 revocation under RCW 43.101.105(2)(e).

8 **COUNT II**

9 Between approximately December 2021 to November 2023, AL SALEHI
10 engaged in conduct that failed to meet the ethical and professional standards required
11 of a peace officer and/or disrupted, diminished, or otherwise jeopardized public trust
12 or confidence in the law enforcement profession when he: (1) repeatedly contacted
13 and harassed a female citizen online and via text message; and/or (2) made false
14 and/or misleading statements during a criminal investigation related to the harassment
15 described in (1); and/or (3) based on the harassment described in (1), was criminally
16 charged with Domestic Violence Cyberstalking (former SMC 12A.06.045)¹ in Seattle
17 Municipal Court Case #668269; and/or (4) was prohibited pursuant to a Stalking No-
18 Contact Order from being within 1,000 feet of the female citizen for a period of five
19 years; and/or (5) was prohibited pursuant to a Stalking No-Contact Order from owning,
20 obtaining, or accessing any firearms or dangerous weapons for a period of five years.
21 AL SALEHI's peace officer certification is subject to discipline under RCW
22 43.101.105(3)(j)(iv).

COUNT III

On or about October 25, 2022, AL SALEHI was terminated from SPD after engaging in the misconduct described in Count II. AL SALEHI's peace officer certification is subject to discipline under RCW 43.101.105(3)(k).
