12	and/or policy of CAMDEN'S employer. This misconduct subjects CAMDEN'S	
13	corrections officer certification to discipline under RCW 43.101.105(3)(e). The	
14	circumstances are as follows:	
15	Count I	
16	On or around June 1, 2022, CAMDEN used force on an inmate that could	
17	reasonably be expected to cause physical injury and violated the policy of the YCDOC	
18	and/or the law. Specifically, CAMDEN'S conduct (1) violated the YCDOC's Employee	
19	Standards of Conduct provision governing the use of force and/or (2) constituted an	
20	impermissible use of force in violation of RCW 10.120.020. CAMDEN'S corrections	
21	officer certification is subject to discipline under RCW 43.101.105(3)(e).
