STATEMENT OF CHARGES

12 Between approximately May 2020 to July 2021, PEREZ PUGA, a certified peace
13 officer with the Seattle Police Department (SPD) engaged in conduct and/or a pattern
14 of conduct that failed to meet the ethical and professional standards of a peace officer;
15 and/or disrupted, diminished or otherwise jeopardized public trust or confidence in the
16 law enforcement profession; and/or demonstrated an inability or unwillingness to uphold
17 his sworn oath to enforce the Constitution and laws of the United States and the state
18 of Washington. His certification is subject to discipline under RCW 43.101.105(3)(j)(iv).
19 The circumstances are as follows:

20 **Count I**

21 Between approximately May 2020 to July 2021, PEREZ PUGA engaged in
22 conduct and/or a pattern of conduct that failed to meet the ethical and professional
23 standards of a peace officer and/or disrupted, diminished, or otherwise jeopardized
24 public trust or confidence in the law enforcement profession when he: (1) repeatedly
25 sent threatening, intimidating, demeaning, and/or harassing text messages to his
26 then-current domestic partner; and/or (2) engaged in conduct and/or a pattern of

1 conduct constituting the crime of Harassment Through Electronic Communications, a
2 gross misdemeanor under RCW 9A.46.020. PEREZ PUGA's peace officer certification
3 is subject to discipline under RCW 43.101.105(3)(j)(iv).
