STATEMENT OF CHARGES

On or about August 15, 2024, the Washington State Criminal Justice Training Commission (Commission) received a complaint alleging that JULIO VALENCIA, a certified peace officer with the Colville Police Department (CPD), engaged in conduct that failed to meet the ethical and professional standards required of a peace officer. On or about September 21, 2024, VALENCIA resigned from the CPD while under investigation by that agency. Following its own independent investigation, the Commission determined that VALENCIA’S certification is subject to discipline pursuant to RCW 43.101.105(3)(j)(iv) and (3)(k). The circumstances are as follows:

**Count I**

Between December 2023 and February 2025, VALENCIA engaged in conduct or a pattern of conduct that failed to meet the ethical and professional standards of a peace officer and/or disrupted, diminished, or otherwise jeopardized public trust or confidence in the law enforcement profession when he: (1) while on-duty as a peace officer, had sexual contact with at least two women he met while responding to calls for

1 service; and/or (2) initiated a sexual relationship with a high school student he met while  
2 responding to a call regarding the student's whereabouts and wellbeing; and/or (3)  
3 continued to contact the student against her wishes, to the extent she felt it necessary  
4 to obtain a Harassment Protection Order against him (Stevens County District Court  
5 Case No. CVY25-020). VALENCIA'S peace officer certification is subject to discipline  
6 under RCW 43.101.105(3)(j)(iv).

7 AND/OR

8 **Count II**

9 On or about September 21, 2024, VALENCIA separated from his employment  
10 with the CPD after engaging in the misconduct described in Count I, subsections (1)  
11 and (2). VALENCIA'S peace officer certification is subject to discipline under  
12 RCW 43.101.105(3)(k).
